The hospital, built in 2007, receives medical equipment from Cuba and Medical Brigade doctors to provide free care. The hospital serves a community of more than 30,000 (60,000 including the surrounding area). To date, it has provided free medical consultations and medicine to more than 500,000 Garifuna patients. It is the only free hospital in Honduras.
